MEETING PRESENTATION

The meeting topic for this month was "Planning Your Research Trip in 2023" and was presented by Clevlyn Anderson, William Durant, and Dawnya Lindsey.

Clevlyn began the presentation covering the subtopics in more detail.

- Clevlyn, William and Dawnya each shared their experiences during their research trips in Mississippi, South Carolina and Georgia
 - Clevlyn shared how she prepared for her research trip to Macon, Mississippi. This included pre-planning such as what she wanted to research, what information she already knew, where she wanted to conduct her research and created a plan. She used older and current maps to understand where her family lived and how they moved around in the county. Another tip she shared was to understand the history of the county you are researching.



Know what records you are looking for and where to find them (archives, courthouse, library, etc.).

- William shared how he ended up transcribing the Durant cemetery. He shared the pictures and transcription to local genealogical societies where this information was printed. He also shared his research about his maternal 3x great grandfather who founded a church in Orangeburg.
- Dawnya shared that her family always assumed their family's origins was in Ohio. She later found out he was from Chattanooga, TN while doing genealogical research.
 She referenced a map and noted Chattanooga was a city that bordered Georgia.
